PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY / FUNCTION: Responsible for implementing the after school programming for youth ages 6-17 years.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Oversees program activities; supervise and assist Site Coordinators at program site.
- Provide youth with support and guidance through life skills programs.
- Provide educational programs focused on improving youth's overall academic achievement.
- Assist youth with homework and enhance academic performance.
- Maintain accurate records of timesheets for site coordinators.
- Review youth's files to ensure that all appropriate documents are on file.
- Submit monthly reports (narrative of monthly activities of youth programs, daily activities, and enrollment and termination forms) to Program Development Manager.
- Assist as needed in providing snacks and mini meals for youth.
- Ensure site is maintained in a condition that is safe, clean, and conducive to learning.
- Serve as a mentor by providing a positive and professional example.
- Provide transportation of youth to activities as needed.
- Performs other related duties as required.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Digital dexterity necessary for keyboard operation. Visual acuity necessary for use of the computer screen. Ability to lift up to 25 pounds. Ability to work in a constant state of alertness and in a safe manner. Ability to concentrate for long periods of time.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

Work is performed primarily in a smoking restricted environment with frequent visits to outside agencies and at departmental activities and functions. Weekend and evening work may be required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Completion of a bachelor's degree in Education, Communication, or a related field; considerable experience working with youth; or any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the required skills, knowledge, and abilities.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

Must possess or be able to immediately obtain a valid Arkansas Driver's License.

Employment is contingent upon satisfactory completion of the following pre-employment requirements: criminal background check, sexual offender check, child maltreatment check, and an adult maltreatment check.
